We are expecting God to do abundantly above all that we ask or think and that He will get all the glory, honor, and praise in all that is done, in Jesus name.

PRAY:

- 1. That the mission team consists only of those whom God has chosen to serve him in Nicaragua consisting of medical, non-medical and ensuring the that the team includes a musician.
- 2. That all the team and hosts will be continually be filled with the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 5:18)
- 3. That God supply all the needs of the CBC team and the Nicaraguan partners (Phil 4:19)
- 4. That by God's grace and the team's obedience the established *Timelines for the Nicaraguan Medical Missions Trip* will be met.
- 5. That Luke 9:23 would become a lifestyle, Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.
- 6. That the team would be diligent in prayer and fasting (Ezra 8:21; Matthew 17:21)
- 7. That God would meet all the spiritual and temporal needs of the people to whom we minister (Phil 4:19)
- 8. That the team rests in preparation for their departure to mission field (Mark 6:31)
- 9. Divine protection for team from hurt, harm and danger.

- 21. Adaptation to food and surroundings
- 22. Missionaries would grow in grace and the knowledge of Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18)
- 23. Clear communications in spite of language barrier
- 24. Abundant Harvest of souls (Matthew 16:18; Luke 5:5-11; John 15:5; John 21:6; Acts 2:47)
- 25. For excellent physical health for all members of mission team. (Philippians 4:13; 3 John 1-2)
- Commitment of each missionary to give their utmost for Jesus Christ (Romans 12:1; 1 Corinthians 15:58)

- 27. Boldness for our team to extend themselves in love (Ephesians 6:18; 1Corinthians 13:1-3)
- 28. For sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading (Ephesians 4:30; 1 Thessalonians 5:19)
- 29. For peace of mind trusting in the sovereignty of God (Isaiah 26:3, John 16:33)
- 30. For awareness of the spiritual warfare around them (Ephesians 6:10-18)
- 31. For willingness to pray earnestly (Luke 18:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- 32. Good fellowship with co-laborers (Romans 12:10)
- For godly relationship and fellowship among missionaries, cooperation, humility, submission to each other and unity (Phil 2:1-4)
